

Dear Parents,



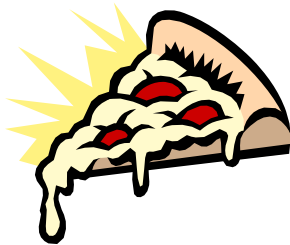
Our fourth graders have been learning about the problems of rain forest destruction, and they would like to take action! Once again, our school is participating in the Adopt an Acre campaign sponsored by the Earth Foundation. This service project involves raising money through the purchase of T-shirts and other items. For every 10 items purchased, one acre of rain forest is adopted and given to the Nature Conservancy to manage. Last year over 1,000 schools took part in this project. Amazingly, Stoney Point was Number 3 in the nation in acres of rain forest saved! We sold 1175 shirts and saved 117.5 acres!

Because we saved over 100 acres, a Stoney Point teacher won a free 10-day trip to the rain forest in Costa Rica. Mrs. Moody was the lucky winner last year . . . who will it be this year???? Since the Adopt-an-Acre campaign is focusing on the rain forests of Madagascar this year, we are going to show Madagascar II. To be sure we don't leave anyone out, we are asking parents to complete the form below and send it to your child's teacher. That way we can combine orders from different siblings to determine which families have saved an acre.

If you would like to help us by collecting orders from friends and family, you may request additional order forms. We appreciate any help with this project, but please don't allow your child to sell door-to-door. We request that students take orders only from family members and close friends. Parents are welcome to help by taking orders at work. The due date for T-shirt orders is Tuesday, April 7th.
