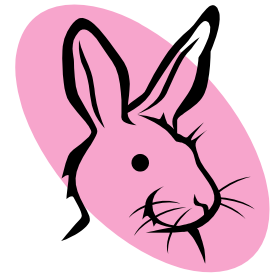
3. Mrs. Jones' class hatched chicks. Seven chicks were yellow, six chicks were white and two chicks were black. How many chicks hatched in all?
