**Bingo Showdown**

**Team Directions**

- Each person chooses a Bingo board having numbers 1 - 24 and a free space. Shuffle the deck of numbered task cards and place them face down in the center of the team.
- Choose the first Bingo Captain (this role will rotate). The Bingo Captain turns over the top card and reads the first question or problem aloud.
- Without talking, each person solves the problem and writes the answer on his or her dry erase board. Everyone turns their dry erase boards face down when ready.
- When everyone's boards are face down, the Bingo Captain says "Showdown!" Everyone shows their solutions. Everyone who is not sure of the correctness of their answers and gives up.
- Everyone who has a correct answer gets a point.

**Bingo Showdown** is a variation of the classic Bingo game that can be used for whole group instruction, small guided reading groups, cooperative learning teams, or in learning centers. This packet includes directions for how to create your own Bingo Showdown review game, as well as all the materials you'll need for your students. You'll find 40 Bingo boards, Team Directions, 24 blank Calling Cards, and a blank Answer Key. You can write on the PDF version of the cards and answer key, or type directly onto the Word versions of those documents included in the zip file.

### Advanced Preparation

1. Print one Bingo board per person (1/2 page) and laminate them. You can use the same set of numbered Bingo boards all year with different Bingo games.
2. Use the blank calling cards template to create a set of 24 cards with math problems or content-area questions that have short answers. Create an answer key to match and write the topic of the activity at the top of the answer key. Here are some ideas to get you started:

Calling Cards	Answer Key
Definitions of key terms	Vocabulary words
Capital cities	State abbreviations
Sentences with underlined words	Parts of speech
Math word problems	Solutions
Word names	Expanded form

3. Duplicate one set of cards and one answer key per team on card stock or construction paper. To save time during class, cut the cards apart in advance and store them in a snack-sized plastic bag labeled with the game topic.
4. To use the activity in a center, glue the Team Directions onto the front of a 9" x 12" brown envelope and store the Bingo boards and other materials inside.

## How to Play Bingo Showdown

1. Demonstrate the game to the class before allowing them to play in teams or centers. Give each student a numbered Bingo card and a handful of Bingo chips or markers for covering the spaces. Dried kidney beans work well if you don't have plastic game pieces. For the class game, you only need one set of calling cards and one answer key.
2. Display the Bingo Showdown Team Directions for the class and tell them that for this round you will serve as the Bingo Captain. Model each step of the displayed directions using your prepared calling cards and the answer key. Make sure students know to place their boards face down after they write their answers. When you say, "Showdown!" they turn their boards over and reveal their answers. Discuss the solutions and any errors, and remind them of the importance of doing this in their team games. Only students who have the correct answer may cover the corresponding numbered space on the game board.
3. After you play at least one game with the class, give each team a deck of calling cards and an answer key. While they play in teams or in centers, circulate through the room helping students as needed. You can also create one group of students who need extra help and work with them directly while the other teams play on their own.

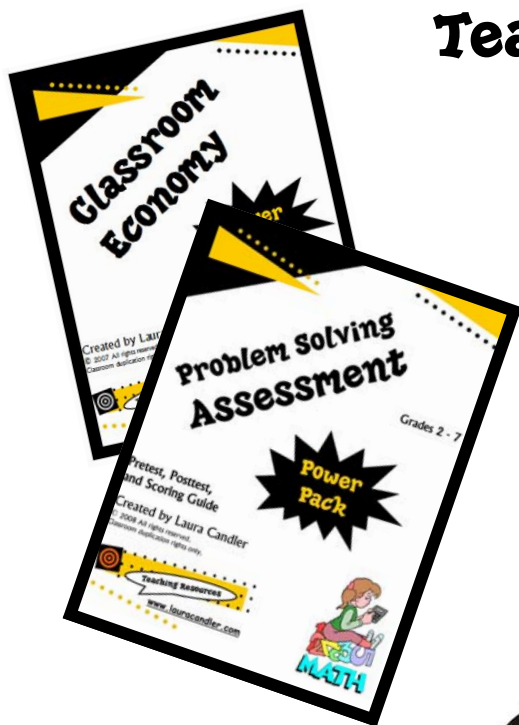
