

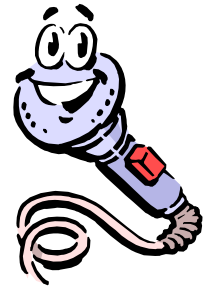
Talk Show

Materials: 1 set of question cards
2 “microphones” per team

Directions:

1. Spread question cards face up in the center of each team. Roll up 2 half sheets of paper to create 2 microphones.
2. One person volunteers to be the first “guest” and the others become the interviewers.
3. Both the guest and the person to his or her left hold the microphones. The interviewer asks a question by selecting a question card or making up a question.
4. The guest answers, and the interviewer microphone is passed clockwise to the next interviewer. Continue until each interviewer has asked one question.
5. Pass the guest microphone to the left and repeat steps 1 - 4 with that person becoming the new guest. Interviewers may ask previously-used questions from the deck.

What do you like to do in your free time after school or on weekends?

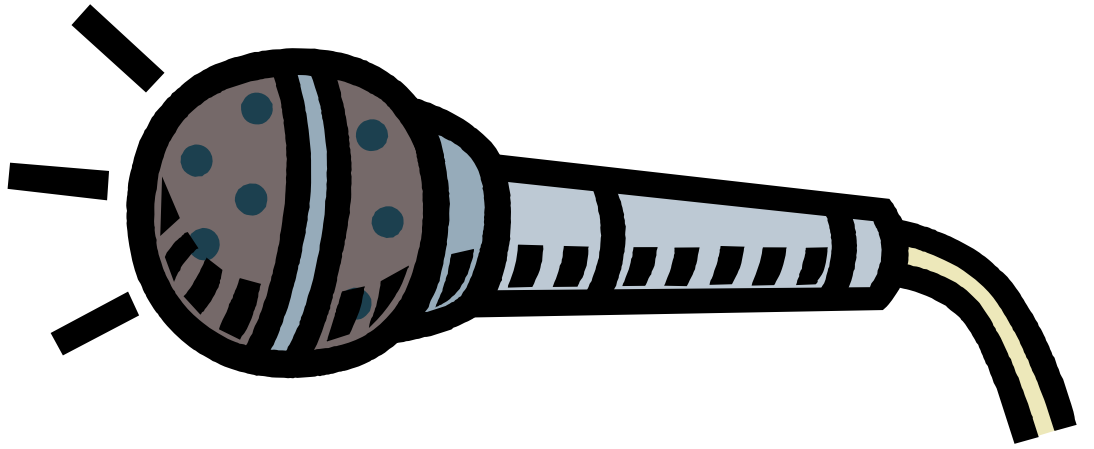
What do you dream of becoming or doing one day in the future?
