Modeling Clay Recipe

What you need:

- * 1 cup flour
- * 1/2 cup salt
- * 2 teaspoons cream of tartar
- * 1 cup water
- * 1 tablespoon vegetable oil
- * Food coloring to your liking

What to do:

- 1. Combine the dry ingredients, then the liquids in a pan.
- 2. Heat slowly, stirring constantly, until thickened.
- 3. Remove from heat, take out of the pan and knead until smooth. The dough should be very stiff. If not, add more flour.
- 4. Store in an air tight container.
