
Verb Roace

Materials:

Verb Race Game Board and Past Tense Verb Cards Different color game marker for each player One die Dry Erase Boards and Markers

Directions:

- 1. Stack the Verb Cards face down near the Game Board. Choose your game markers and place them on or near Start.
- 2. Choose a Leader to go first. The Leader secretly flips over a Verb Card and calls out the verb (not the answer which is in parentheses).
- 3. The other players write the correct past tense form of the verb on their dry erase boards.
- 4. The Leader checks the spelling of each past tense verb.
- 5. Every player who wrote the word correctly may roll the die to see how many spaces to move forward.
- 6. Rotate the role of Leader for each round.
- 7. The winner is the player who lands on or passes the End first.
