

Tricky Words Bingo by Laura Candler

Tricky Words Bingo is a fun way for students to practice using 24 commonly-confused word correctly. The game can be played with the entire class during whole group instruction, and it's also perfect for small guided literacy groups, cooperative learning teams, and learning centers. This PDF teacher's guide includes a Tricky Words review activity, 30 numbered Bingo boards, Bingo Showdown Directions, 24 Tricky Words Task Cards, and an answer key. The product also includes three editable resources you can use to modify the words and task cards.

Advanced Preparation

Review the Tricky Words Clouds on page 4 and the Tricky Words Task Cards (pages 6-8) to be sure the words and sentences are appropriate for your students. If you want to make changes, you can customize the Tricky Words Clouds page, the sentences on the task cards, and the answer key by using the editable versions of those pages located in a separate folder.

Print one 1/2 page Bingo board per person, plus one set of Tricky Words Task Cards and one answer key for each game. Cut the task cards apart and place them in a snack-sized plastic bag before giving the materials to your students. To use the activity in a center, glue the Bingo Showdown Team Directions onto the front of a large 9" x 12" envelope, and store the Bingo boards, task cards, and answer key inside.



Tricky Words Review Lesson

Materials Needed

- Tricky Words Clouds page to display for the class
- Dry erase board and marker for each student

Lesson Directions

Display the Tricky Words clouds page for the class. Point to one cloud and pronounce the two (or three) words on the cloud. Then discuss the meanings and how the words are used.

To check for understanding, ask everyone to write a sentence on their dry erase boards that uses one of the words correctly. When everyone is ready, ask them to hold up their boards for you to check. Call on four or five students who have used the words correctly to come forward and show their examples to the class. Repeat procedure with each cloud.

Tricky Words Bingo Showdown Game

Materials Needed

- Bingo Showdown Directions
- Bingo chips and numbered Bingo boards
- 24 Tricky Words Task Cards with Answer Key
- Dry erase board and marker for each student

Teaching Tips

Tricky Words Bingo Showdown can be played by the whole class or in small groups. Before allowing your students to play the game in groups, introduce it in a whole class setting to be sure everyone understands how to play. Display the Bingo Showdown directions, and give each student a numbered Bingo board and a handful of Bingo chips. Assume the role of Bingo Captain yourself for the first game, and demonstrate the steps as you read them aloud. Emphasize the fact that Tricky Words Bingo is a learning game, so it's important to discuss the answers in Step 4 before players mark their game boards in Step 5.

Read the words on each cloud. What makes them tricky? Are they pronounced exactly the same? How are their meanings different?




Bingo Showdown

Materials

Dry erase boards and markers, numbered Bingo boards, Bingo chips, 24 Task Cards, Answer Key

Team Directions

- 1. Each person takes a Bingo board. Shuffle the deck of task cards and place them face down in the center of the team.
- 2. Decide who will be the first Bingo Captain. Her or she turns over the top card and reads the first sentence aloud.
- 3. Without talking, each person writes the word that correctly completes the sentence on his or her dry erase board. All players turn their dry erase boards face down when ready.
- 4. When all boards are face down, the Bingo Captain says, "Showdown!" Players show their answers, and the Bingo Captain checks them using the answer key. Players discuss how they knew which answer was correct.
- 5. Everyone who was correct covers the number in the upper left corner of the task card on his or her Bingo board.
- 6. Rotate role of Bingo Captain to the left for each round.
- 7. The winner is the first person to cover an entire row horizontally, vertically, or diagonally.

 8. Clear Bingo boards and begin a new game if time allows.





